## Elementary to Middle School Feeder Pattern Analysis

This report arranges each of the "feeder" elementary schools for every WCPSS middle school and displays some student population indicators for each school from 2010-11, including:

Each school's 2010-11 overall proficiency rate (labeled "% Proficient")

The percentage of the student population eligible for free or reduced price lunch (labeled "% FRL")

The percentage of African-American students in the student population (labeled "% Black")

These data were taken from larger databases of school-level information, much of which is available at http://www.wcpss.net/demographics/. While the larger database contained several other indicators relative to the makeup of the school, these indicators were chosen simply to provide a concise look at how the elementary schools "feeding" into each middle school compare to the current makeup of each middle school.

The "Elementary School Data 2010-11" columns simply show the 2010-11 data for each elementary school.

The "Weighted Average Across Elementary Cluster" columns aggregate those data together for each set of elementary feeders so that each is counted proportional to the number of students in each school, assuming 100% capacity.

The "2010-11 Actual Middle School Data" column shows the 2010-11 data for those same indicators at each

The "Middle School Rank 2010-11 (High to Low)" column shows the ranking of each middle school on each of those three indicators. For example, Apex Middle School had the 6th highest proficiency rate among all WCPSS middle schools in 2010-11, so it has a "6" in that column.

The "Elementary Cluster Rank 2010-11 (High to Low)" column shows the ranking of each set of feeder elementary schools on each of those three indicators. For example, the feeder elementary schools linked to Apex Middle School, if those elementary schools were to be treated as a single school, would have the 6th highest proficiency rate compared to all of the other elementary school clusters in each middle school feeder
