BACKGROUND

On January 16th, 2014, Dr. June Atkinson sent a letter to all superintendents in the state outlining a series of options that could be used as "good cause exemptions" for students under the requirements of Read to Achieve. As a result of receiving these options, we solicited feedback from both principals and teachers specifically in our year-round elementary schools who were well into the implementation of the Read to Achieve portfolio passage process. We have drafted preliminary recommendations to change our original implementation plan that are aligned to the new options as well as the feedback received from our employees. We would like to present these recommendations to the board for feedback prior to providing official recommendations to our schools.
