

Policy 6200 Proposed Goals and Factors

(3/5/13)

Note: These goals and factors will be used to develop a student assignment plan. The student assignment plan will reflect a balancing of these goals and factors to the extent possible.

Goal---Achievement

Student populations at each school will provide an optimal opportunity for academic success for all students.

Factors

- Provide opportunities for families to select calendar, magnet, and application schools to support the educational needs of their student
- Avoid high concentration of low-performing students
- Avoid high concentration of low-socioeconomic students

Goal---Stability

Students will have the opportunity to stay in their assigned school without experiencing involuntary changes in school assignment.

Factors

- Provide opportunity to stay where you start
- Provide opportunity to have siblings in the same level assigned to the same school
- Provide opportunity for year-round track alignment for siblings

Goal---Proximity

Base school assignments will be within a reasonable distance of the student's home.

Factors

- Allow students living within the walk-zone of a school to attend that school
- Avoid splitting of neighborhoods when developing base attendance areas

Goal---Operational Efficiency

Assignments will optimize the use of school facilities and transportation resources.

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Factors

- Assignments will avoid under-enrolled schools
- Assignments will avoid overcrowded schools
- Assignments will maximize transportation efficiencies
