NAME FOR NEW HIGH SCHOOL FACILITY IN CARY (H-7)

**BACKGROUND**

On or about December 19, 2008, the Board of Education acquired 88.09 acres for use as a high school in the H-7 target area. The site was master planned together with the adjacent Town of Cary park site. Naming of the new high school facility is now requested. The following names are proposed for consideration (1) Green Level High (2) White Oak High, (3) Roberts Road High, and (4) Southwest Cary High.

Green Level High is proposed because of the site's proximity to the Green Level community, and will help to identify the location of the site and establish a community identity for the facility. White Oak High is proposed because it identifies the township in which the school site is located. Roberts Road High is proposed as it identifies the road from which the school will be accessed and will help to specifically identify the location of the site. Southwest Cary High is proposed because it identifies the area of the Town of Cary in which the school site is located.
