

Comparison of Current School-Level Proficiency Status to Proficiency Status under New Base Attendance Areas

NOTES: Proficiency rates are all estimated based on EOG and EOC tests taken in 2011-12, including alternate assessments. Retesting results for students who fail to score proficient on their first attempt are NOT included, because the rate of students taking retests varies considerably by school. Alternative schools are not included in the analysis. The four East Wake HS campuses are treated as a single high school for this analysis.
