1		Authorized Reseller Letter: For the required signed manufacturer statement confirming authorization—will a letter issued by the manufacturer to our distribution partner (e.g., Ingram/Micro, TD Synnex) that names us as an authorized reseller through them be acceptable, or must the letter come directly naming our company as a standalone authorized reseller?	Please provide a letter directly from the manufacturer stating that your company is an authorized reseller of their products.
2		The IFB requires one signed original and one electronic copy on a flash drive. Is it acceptable for the flash drive to contain a single PDF of the full bid package (including all attachments), or do you prefer separate files per section/attachment?	One flash drive containing the full bid package, including all attachments, as a single consolidated file is preferred.
3		The template includes installation quantities (e.g., wall installations + ViVi installation charges). Should installation be quoted as firm fixed unit prices for those line items exactly as listed, or should we provide a separate installation schedule in addition to the template?	Installation charges should include all costs as outlined in the template found on page 4 of the IFB. Vendor may, however, provide separate, itemized pricing for installation services in addition to the total installation costs.
4		Are the displays meant to be installed in one central location or in multiple locations? (i.e., Wake County Schools and/or Central Office locations). If in multiple locations, can you provide locations and number of displays for each location.	<p>(1) Wendall Magnet Middle School 3409 NC-97 Wendell, NC 27591 9 - displays</p> <p>(2) Wendell Magnet Elementary School 3355 Wendell Blvd. Wendell, NC 27591 4 - displays</p>
5		<p>What types of walls are these going to be mounted to? Is additional backing or support going to be required?</p> <p>2. Why are you requesting two separate mount brands?</p> <p>3. Is the plan to run power to these displays with the extension cords to avoid having to run electrical lines?</p>	The displays will be mounted to block and drywall surfaces. Wendell Magnet Middle School has block walls, and Wendell Magnet Elementary has drywall walls.

Can we assume a wall plate will be located next to each display, or will raceway be required to run the cabling to a different location, or will the ViVi unit be used for the input?</p>	<p>Two different mount brands are necessary due to the size and location of the displays at each school.</p> <p>Displays may have wall plates located next to them; however, in some cases, cable tracking may be required.</p> <p>Room numbers and specific locations will be shared with the awarded vendor(s). The awarded vendor(s) will also receive a map of each school identifying the exact installation locations.</p>
<p>6</p>		<p>On the third line of the product page (page 4), it requests (9) 75" TV installs, but there doesn't seem to be any TV's that are ordered to go with that. What (9) tv's are to be installed? The installation for the (6) 75's on the list are the next line down, so those are accounted for.</p>	<p>Please note that six (6) displays are required for this IFB.</p> <p>Additionally, an Addendum will be issued to correct the template provided on page 4 of IFB.</p>
