Part number (103420-000) is the part number for Thomas buses with A/C and will fit either with or without A/C because it comes with shorter rib nuts that will not screw into the evaporator coil. (103420-000) is what we have been installing on all Thomas buses. For the IC bus part number (102718-000) is the correct number. The stop sign part numbers are correct.
